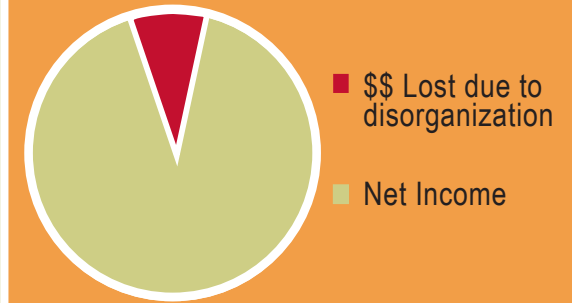


THE HIGH COST OF DISORGANIZATION

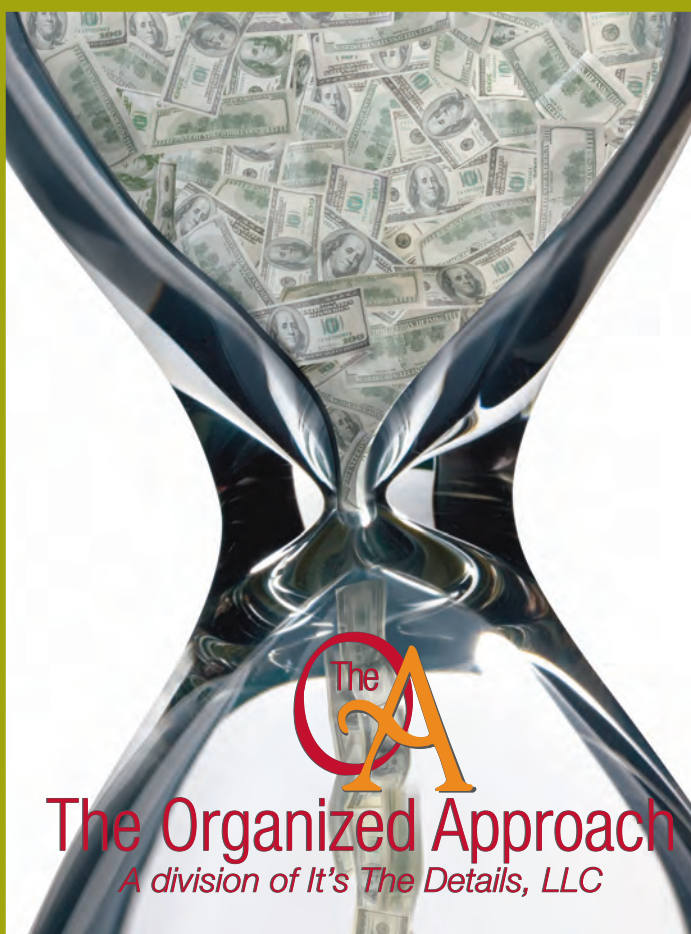
